CHRISTIAN EDUCATION MINISTRY GOALS AND DUTIES

Please be in prayer for the Christian Education Ministry as we strive to accomplish the following goals:

- Make material available through our Resource Library or other outlets such as Right Now Media to which we have access
- Expand the current program of workshops and seminars to offer more centralized training throughout denomination and within each conference
- Aid small churches who are in need by providing, as funds allow, Sunday School Literature for up to two quarters through the "Preparing the Way" program
- Encourage Biblical study with a family focus
- Assist churches in planning and implementing special events such as VBS and teacher/volunteer retreats
- Continue to assist churches in Christian Education through individual program assessments and follow up with the training where it may be needed
- Assist churches in removing barriers and meeting the needs of individuals with disabilities or special needs
- Continue the partnerships with other ministries
- Expand the Camp Scholarship Program as funds are available
- Expand the Woman's Spiritual Life Retreat to nourish the spiritual lives of all women in our denomination
- Offer training and enrichment opportunities for workers to churches who have Day Care Centers
- Offer a Nursery Procedures Manual to all churches, if requested
- Contact each church and or pastor to see if we can assist them in any way with concerns or needs of SS Program

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the Convention officially adopt this annual report of the Christian Education Ministry.
2. That the Convention continue to designate February as Christian Education Ministry Month and churches be encouraged to promote Sunday School and to set aside the last Sunday in February as Sunday School Rally Day.

3. That the Convention encourage all churches to support the Christian Education Ministry both prayerfully and financially.
4. That the Convention encourage all churches to assess their Christian Education programs annually and to partner with this ministry and its resources as they seek to make improvements.
5. That all churches consider assistance with Camp Scholarships in support of youth who need financial help.
6. That the Convention encourages smaller churches to work cooperatively and pool resources for programs such as VBS, Sunday School workshops, and youth work.
7. That the Convention encourages each church to participate in training opportunities such as the LIFE Conference and for local churches to seek training opportunities within their churches, not only from this ministry but throughout our denomination.
